THINGS STUDENTS NEED TO BRING:

Toiletries, personal items to make their room feel like home, prescription medication

SERVICES INCLUDED:

Bed linen, towels, mobile phone use for emergencies

EXTRA COST OF SERVICES:

No; laundry often not available in home; common price for laundry is \$5 for wash and dry at facilities in building or laundromat nearby

MEALS PROVIDED:

Yes (depends on booking type)

⌘ BREAKFAST:

Breakfast is usually a light meal consisting of cereal, fruit, toast, juice, or coffee. Hosts will usually ask you to prepare your own breakfast.

⌘ LUNCH:

You will be responsible for buying your own lunch at school, from a local restaurant, or the local shops.

⌘ DINNER:

You will usually eat dinner with your host, or occasionally you may prepare your own meal with food supplied by your host.

NOTE: Meals provided will differ depending on whether you have selected 14 meals per week or 7 meals per week. If you have booked 7 meals per week, you are responsible for buying your own dinner and you may not have access to the kitchen at certain times
